## Baxter BioScience Grants Program.

<p><b>Description</b></p>	<p>The <b>BioScience Grants program</b> was established to foster advances in scientific research and medical education. With an emphasis on the patient as a priority, the Grants Program is designed to support novel therapeutic discoveries. The Grants Team works closely with the regional and global Medical Affairs teams and cross functional resources in <a href="#">Hemophilia</a>, <a href="#">BioTherapeutics</a>, and <a href="#">BioSurgery</a>, to critically assess each grant request. Grant proposals demonstrating exceptional scientific merit and therapeutic alignment are given priority for funding and product awards.</p>										
<p><b>Amount</b></p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>→ <b>Medical education grants</b> approved by the BioScience Review Committee <b>typically range from \$1,000 to \$25,000</b>, but have exceeded \$100,000 for requests demonstrating exceptional educational need, educational design, and compliance to existing regulations and guidance.</li> <li>→ <b>Research grants</b> approved by the BioScience Review Committee <b>typically range from \$5,000 to \$125,000</b>; requests exceeding this amount must demonstrate exceptional qualities and address critically important medical issues.</li> </ul>

## Wellcome Trust Massachusetts - Institute of Technology (MIT) Postdoctoral Fellowships.

<p><b>Description</b></p>	<p>This scheme offers <b>opportunities for postdoctoral scientists</b> to undertake research at the <b>interfaces between biology/medicine and mathematics, engineering, computer, physical or chemical sciences, firstly at MIT and then at a UK institution.</b></p> <p>Candidates will be expected to identify an <b>important biomedical research question</b> and to propose a <b>personal interdisciplinary training programme</b> to achieve their research aims.</p> <p>The aim is to support those who will train in a new research area that is complementary to, but distinct from, their current field of expertise, to enable an interdisciplinary approach to their research question - e.g. you might be a physicist wanting to work on a biology-based programme, or a biologist wanting to undertake a bio-engineering project.</p>
<p><b>Amount</b></p>	<p>The fellowship is for <b>four years full-time</b>, with the fellow based at MIT for two to three years (<b>Phase 1</b>) before returning to a host institution in the UK for the remainder of the award (<b>Phase 2</b>).</p> <p><b>For Phase 1</b>, the Wellcome Trust will provide a stipend, at a level to be determined by your MIT faculty sponsor(s), and additional support to cover miscellaneous expenses including travel, health insurance and small items of equipment. The MIT faculty sponsor(s) will meet all research costs.</p> <p><b>For Phase 2</b>, the Wellcome Trust will consider providing an appropriate salary for the fellow, research expenses (to cover materials and consumables, animals, if justified, and modest equipment) for the one- to two-year period back in the UK.</p>
<p><b>Eligibility</b></p>	<p>These awards are open to <b>individuals with a <a href="#">relevant connection to the European Economic Area</a>.</b></p> <p>If you have already spent a year or more training or working in an academic or research institution in the United States, <b>you are not eligible to apply to this scheme.</b></p> <p>You should be <b>about to submit your doctoral thesis or have up to, but no more than, three years' postdoctoral experience</b> from date of your PhD viva to the deadline for applications to the scheme.</p> <p>You may have a background in any appropriate field of study (e.g. biology or medicine or chemistry or physics) but <b>you must propose to address an important biomedical research question.</b></p> <p>The proposed research should fall within the Wellcome Trust's normal funding remit.</p> <p><b>You will require:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• an <b>MIT faculty sponsor(s)</b> who can guarantee that MIT will meet all your research costs while you are based in their laboratory, including research expenses and access to equipment - he/she must have a contract of employment at MIT and have tenure beyond the duration of the proposed fellowship</li> <li>• a <b>UK mentor</b> who will provide you with independent support and advice for the duration of the award.</li> </ul> <p><b>Resubmissions are not allowed.</b></p>
