EACR-AICR Travel Fellowship

Deadline	There are three deadlines each year for the submission of applications: 31 March , 31 July and 30 November .
Description	The EACR (European Association for Cancer Research) Travel Fellowship scheme, supported by AICR (Association for International Cancer Research) , typically provides awards of up to €2500 (or €4000 match-funded) to fund collaborative or educational trips to centres of excellence around the world and attendance at training courses and workshops. The scheme is designed to assist postgraduate students and early-career researchers with less than 10 years post-doctoral experience.
Funding	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> The value of each award is typically up to 2,500 Euros - exceptions will be considered where a strong case can be made. Longer-Stay Awards: Where a longer fellowship is desirable, perhaps comprising two periods of research collaboration, EACR will provide 50% match funding up to 4,000 Euros. Applicants must clearly indicate the source of match funding on such applications as EACR will wish to make contact with the co-funders.
Eligibility	The scheme is open to those who have been Student or Active members of the Association for at least 12 months prior to the application and all applicants must be sponsored by two members of the EACR.

EMBO Long-Term Fellowships

Deadline	Opens 6 weeks prior to the application deadline; 1 January for the 15 February deadline and 1 July for the 15 August deadline.
Description	<p>The EMBO (European Molecular Biology Organization) Long-Term Fellowships are awarded for a period of up to two years and support post-doctoral research visits to laboratories throughout Europe and the world. International exchange is a key feature in the application process.</p> <p>All fellowships must involve movement between countries. The receiving institute or the applicant's nationality must be from one of the EMBC Member States.</p>
Funding	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • The stipend is a subsistence allowance and is intended to cover the cost of living in the host country. Subsistence rates depend on the country being visited. • EMBO provides additional allowances for dependent children (i.e. children under the age of 18). Those allowances depend on the country being visited. • The travel allowance is intended to cover travel costs for the fellow and his family to and from the receiving institute. Eligibility	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Applicants must hold a doctorate degree or equivalent at the start of the fellowship. • Applicants who already hold a PhD degree at the time of application are eligible to apply only if they passed their PhD exam in the two years prior to the respective application deadline • Applicants must have at least one first author publication accepted in press or published in an international peer reviewed journal at the time of application. <p>For detailed eligibility criteria applicants should read the Long-Term Fellowships guidelines.</p>

Deadline	20 August, 2013
Description	For its annual awards for science mentorship in 2013, Nature invites nominations of outstanding scientific mentors in Italy .
Funding	Two prizes of €10,000 will be awarded, one for a mid-career mentor and one for life-time achievement in mentoring.

COST (European Cooperation in Science and Technology)

<p>Deadline</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> For submissions in one of the nine COST Domains: 27 September 2013. Full proposals will be invited by 22 November 2013 for submission by 24 January 2014. For Trans-Domain Proposal (TDP) submissions there is first a proposal registration deadline on 27 September 2013, followed by a proposal submission deadline on 8 November 2013.
<p>Description</p>	<p>COST is one of the longest-running European instruments supporting cooperation among scientists and researchers across Europe. COST is also the first and widest European intergovernmental network for coordination of nationally funded research activities. COST is organised in nine broad Domains (including Biomedicine and Molecular Biosciences; Chemistry and Molecular Sciences, Technologies and Physics and Nanosciences, etc).</p> <p>Applicants are invited to locate their topic within one domain. However, inter-disciplinary proposals not fitting readily into a single domain are particularly welcome and will be assessed separately.</p>
<p>Funding</p>	<p>The support will cover the costs of networking activities such as meetings (e.g. travel, subsistence, local organiser support), conferences, workshops, short-term scientific exchanges, training schools, publications and dissemination activities.</p> <p>COST does not fund the research itself.</p> <p>Financial support for an action of 19 participating countries is in the range of EUR 130 000 p.a., normally for four years, subject to available budget.</p>
<p>Eligibility</p>	<p>The Proposer must be affiliated to a legal entity based in a COST Member Country or Cooperating State. The network must be composed by researchers affiliated to legal entities from at least five different COST Member Countries/Cooperating State.</p>

Wellcome Trust Massachusetts - Institute of Technology (MIT) Postdoctoral Fellowships.

Deadline	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • 12 July 2013 • Shortlisted candidate interviews: 13-15 November 2013
Description	<p>This scheme offers opportunities for postdoctoral scientists to undertake research at the interfaces between biology/medicine and mathematics, engineering, computer, physical or chemical sciences, firstly at MIT and then at a UK institution.</p> <p>Candidates will be expected to identify an important biomedical research question and to propose a personal interdisciplinary training programme to achieve their research aims.</p> <p>The aim is to support those who will train in a new research area that is complementary to, but distinct from, their current field of expertise, to enable an interdisciplinary approach to their research question - e.g. you might be a physicist wanting to work on a biology-based programme, or a biologist wanting to undertake a bio-engineering project.</p>
Funding	<p>The fellowship is for four years full-time, with the fellow based at MIT for two to three years (Phase 1) before returning to a host institution in the UK for the remainder of the award (Phase 2).</p> <p>For Phase 1, the Wellcome Trust will provide a stipend, at a level to be determined by your MIT faculty sponsor(s), and additional support to cover miscellaneous expenses including travel, health insurance and small items of equipment. The MIT faculty sponsor(s) will meet all research costs.</p> <p>For Phase 2, the Wellcome Trust will consider providing an appropriate salary for the fellow, research expenses (to cover materials and consumables, animals, if justified, and modest equipment) for the one- to two-year period back in the UK.</p>
Eligibility	<p>These awards are open to individuals with a relevant connection to the European Economic Area.</p> <p>If you have already spent a year or more training or working in an academic or research institution in the United States, you are not eligible to apply to this scheme.</p> <p>You should be about to submit your doctoral thesis or have up to, but no more than, three years' postdoctoral experience from date of your PhD viva to the deadline for applications to the scheme.</p> <p>You may have a background in any appropriate field of study (e.g. biology or medicine or chemistry or physics) but you must propose to address an important biomedical research question.</p> <p>The proposed research should fall within the Wellcome Trust's normal funding remit.</p> <p>You will require:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • an MIT faculty sponsor(s) who can guarantee that MIT will meet all your research costs while you are based in their laboratory, including research expenses and access to equipment - he/she must have a contract of employment at MIT and have tenure beyond the duration of the proposed fellowship • a UK mentor who will provide you with independent support and advice for the duration of the award. <p>Resubmissions are not allowed.</p>

Armenise Harvard Foundation - Career Development Award Program

Description	<p>The Giovanni Armenise-Harvard Foundation has funds to support the development of talented scientists and to contribute to the establishment of novel areas of research in biological sciences in Italy.</p> <p>The Career Development Award provides three to five years of support for newly independent scientists at an agreed host institute in Italy. It is intended to foster the development of outstanding scientists and enable them to expand their potential to make significant contributions to their field of research.</p>
Funding	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • The Award will initially be granted for three years, will be available from July 1 each year and will be distributed annually at a rate of \$200,000 per year per scholar. • Funds can cover salaries for the scholar (commensurate with position at the host institute), technicians, junior scientists, research supplies or administrative support required for the program. • The host institute must provide the facilities, equipment, and infrastructure necessary to carry out the proposed research. However, up to 25% of the funds can be used for administrative costs associated with the program in the host department.
Eligibility	<p>Candidates must:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Be young, emerging scientists with demonstrated productivity and the capacity to function as an independent investigator. Experience of working with or at HMS is an advantage but not essential. • They should have a minimum of 3 years of postdoctoral research experience in basic biological sciences (of which at least two years should be abroad) and be no more than 10 years beyond their Ph.D. • Be researchers not currently living in Italy who wish to enter the Italian research community. • Have an agreement for development of a novel research area in a suitable host institution in Italy. • Applications from candidates who have a pre-existing appointment at an Italian host institute will not be considered, although the offer of a tenure-track position is desirable.
