FP7 CALLS FOR PROPOSALS: 2013 CALLS NOW OPEN

The European Commission have launched **52 calls for proposals and two prizes for the 2013 FP7 calls**. The total budget for the calls is **around EUR 8 billion**, and these are the final calls to be launched under FP7.

The **majority of funding under the 2013 FP7 calls** will be provided through the **four specific programmes**:

- Cooperation;
- Ideas (the **European Research Council**);
- People (the **Marie Curie Actions**);
- Capacities.

FOCUS: THE HEALTH WORK PROGRAMME 2013.

The **Health work programme 2013** has an indicative budget of **EUR ~840 million** to cover many health issues. The research priorities for 2013 are: brain research, **antimicrobial drug resistance** and comparative effectiveness research, complemented by topics from other areas such as **developing personalised medicines approaches**, cardiovascular research, safety and efficacy of therapies, **cancer and public health research** and a **horizontal activity for translating research results into innovative applications for health**.

AACR-KURE IT GRANT FOR KIDNEY CANCER RESEARCH

Description	The AACR-Kure It Grant for Kidney Cancer Research represents a joint effort to promote and support innovative cancer research. This grant is available to independent investigators to develop and study new ideas and approaches that have direct application and relevance to kidney cancer patients.
Amount	This 2-year grant provides \$250,000 over the grant term (\$125,000 per year).
Eligibility	Applicants must have a doctoral degree (including Ph.D., M.D., D.O., D.C., N.D., D.D.S., D.V.M., Sc.D., D.N.S., Pharm.D., or equivalent doctoral degree, or a combined clinical and research doctoral degree) in a related field and not currently be a candidate for a further doctoral or professional degree. Applications will be accepted from independent investigators who are affiliated with an academic, medical or research institution anywhere in the world. There are no citizenship or geographic requirements.

PREMIO BIOECONOMY ROME 2012

Descrizione	In occasione della seconda edizione del Premio BioEconomy Rome (2012) , il consorzio pubblico privato CNCCS (Collezione Nazionale Composti Chimici e Centro Screening) - costituito nel 2010 dal Consiglio Nazionale delle Ricerche (CNR), dall'Istituto Superiore di Sanità (ISS), e da IRBM Science Park - ha istituito 10 Premi di Ricerca destinati a promuovere l'eccellenza scientifica di giovani ricercatori/innovatori che lavorino in Italia. L'ambito è quello delle ricerche traslazionali nel campo delle malattie rare, neglette e della povertà .
Amount	Il premio consiste nella somma di quindicimila dollari (\$ 15.000)
Elegibilità	I candidati devono: 1. avere meno di quaranta anni di età alla data del 31 dicembre 2012; 2. lavorare in Italia da almeno cinque anni alla data del 31 dicembre 2012; 3. avere un CV eccellente , prevalentemente orientato allo studio delle malattie rare o delle malattie neglette o di quelle della povertà, e devono aver conseguito il titolo di "Dottore di Ricerca" in Italia o titolo equivalente all'estero; 4. essere autori, come primo o ultimo nome, di almeno cinque pubblicazioni in riviste internazionali . Costituisce titolo di merito la presenza nel CV di brevetti o almeno di richieste di brevetto che abbiano un impatto socioeconomico nel campo delle malattie rare, neglette o della povertà.

PEZCOLLER FOUNDATION-AACR INTERNATIONAL AWARD FOR CANCER RESEARCH

Description	<p>The Pezcoller Foundation–AACR International Award for Cancer Research was established in 1997 to annually recognize a scientist of international renown:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • who has made a major scientific discovery in basic cancer research OR who has made significant contributions to translational cancer research; • who continues to be active in cancer research and has a record of recent, noteworthy publications; and • whose ongoing work holds promise for continued substantive contributions to progress in the field of cancer.
Amount	The award consists of an unrestricted grant of €75,000 , commemorative plaque, and full support to the winner and a guest to attend the AACR Annual Meeting. .
Eligibility	Eligible candidates are cancer researchers affiliated with institutions in academia, industry, or government that are involved in cancer research, cancer medicine, or cancer-related biomedical science anywhere in the world.

EUROPEAN COOPERATION IN SCIENCE AND TECHNOLOGY (COST): OPEN CALL

Description	<p>COST – European Cooperation in Science and Technology – is one of the longest-running European instruments supporting cooperation among scientists and researchers across Europe. COST is also the first and widest European intergovernmental network for coordination of nationally funded research activities.</p> <p>COST is organised in nine broad Domains (including Biomedicine and Molecular Biosciences; Chemistry and Molecular Sciences, Technologies and Physics and Nanosciences, etc). Applicants are invited to locate their topic within one domain. However, inter-disciplinary proposals not fitting readily into a single domain are particularly welcome and will be assessed separately.</p>
Budget	<p>COST does NOT fund research itself, but supports networking activities such as meetings, conferences, short-term scientific exchanges and outreach activities.</p> <p>Financial support for an Action of 19 participating countries is in the range of EUR 130 000 p.a. for normally four years, subject to available budget.</p>
Eligibility	Proposals should include researchers from a minimum of five COST countries .
